

In February 1918, 30 women in the UK who owned their own property became eligible to vote. The year 1975 is seen in history as the 'Red Letter Year'. Because in the same year, the United Nations officially recognized 'World Women's Day'. This was followed by the celebration of International Women's Day on March 8.
